Dear Sir/Madam

Your General Exemption application to the Ministry of Trade & Industry (MTI) for your essential workers (including employees) to work on-site for the duration of the circuit breaker has been approved. The list of approved workers can be found in **Annex A**. Your workers may check for the approval by using the [SGWorkPass](#) app to scan the barcode on their NRIC/ICA Pass card, or the QR code of their work pass card.

Should there be further changes to the manpower details submitted by your company, you must [re-submit the details](#) by 8pm one day before the workers are deployed for work.

As you continue to operate during this period, you are required to comply with all applicable laws, including the provisions of the *COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act*. Businesses might be required to suspend operations should any of their staff working on-site become infected with COVID-19.

IMPORTANT

You must implement [SafeEntry](#) at your workplace, and ensure that your workers have downloaded and activated the [TraceTogether](#) app.

You should also remind your workers to carry their identification documents (NRIC, ICA or MOM-issued pass card) at all times to facilitate verification checks by relevant Government authorities.

The Multi-Ministry Taskforce had earlier announced that from 21 Apr 2020, daily movement of workers housed in dormitories (i.e. Purpose Built Dormitories, Factory Converted Dormitories, Construction Temporary Quarters and Temporary Occupation Licence quarters) is no longer allowed. You should approach your sector lead agency if you wish to deploy your approved workers housed in dormitories to work on-site in your company's premises.

Workers who are currently serving mandatory Quarantine Orders (QOs), Stay-Home Notices (SHNs) or Leave of Absence (LOA) are not allowed to work on-site, until they have completed serving these requirements.
